## Roads:

Mr. Hebert informed the Board that he and Adam Dow visited the roads that the Board of Selectmen would like to tend to in 2024. He presented a spreadsheet outlining three of the roads and potential costs estimates for budgetary purposes only. Mr. Hebert will continue looking at Hidden Ln, WB Hill, Greenwood, Blueberry, Sargent St, Dearborn and Lower Forrest.

Board agreed to add the estimates to the meeting minutes (see attached).

## • Buildings:

Mrs. Giovannucci reached out to SMP Architecture in Concord to get an idea of what a feasibility study would cost. She added that she explained the current conditions of our 4 structures (Town Hall, Police Station, Highway Garage and Transfer Station), and that we'd be looking for what repairs the buildings need, layout restructuring, use of the same space or other options, etc. Mrs. Giovannucci asked if \$50,000 would be about enough for budgetary purposes, and SMP stated that without seeing the buildings, they feel it would be enough.

Boudreau/Davis moved to present a warrant article to the Board of Selectmen for \$50,000 for a feasibility study. Motion Passed.

Sel. Cunningham stated that if a lot of work is done to a structure you lose the grandfather clause and have to upgrade to be ADA compliant. Mr. Davis confirmed that it's 50% of construction.

Mr. Boudreau asked Mr. Colby if he felt the Police Department was moving towards accreditation. Mr. Colby stated that currently they are focused on building the department, but feels eventually they will move in that direction, he added that there's a lot that goes into that and to get to that point.
